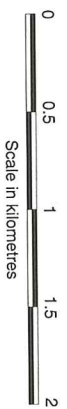

Most of the mountain trails are maintained to wilderness standards only. Hikers should be prepared for steep, rough terrain and many unmarked hazards and obstacles. Please report any unsafe conditions or trail blockages to Buntzen Lake Recreation Area Warden, either in person or by calling 604 469-9679.

- Don't get locked in. Note gate closing times.
- Do not hike alone.
- Be prepared for rapid changes in weather.
- Tell someone of your destination and intended time of return.
- Take an accurate map and emergency supplies.
